



Scholarship/Stipend Memorandum of Understanding

MARCHING SYCAMORES

For ALL scholarships/stipend categories, the following member requirements are applicable:

- Must attend Band Camp prior to the start of the Fall semester.
- Must be a member in good standing (no financial obligations).
- Must be enrolled in the class at the time disbursements are made.
- Must participate in ALL scheduled, required performances (football games, parades, other) as designated by the Director.

For specific scholarships/stipends, the following additional requirements are also applicable:

CATEGORY A – LEADERSHIP (\$200)

In order to qualify for this scholarship, the following conditions must be met:

- Must be a member of the leadership team of the Marching Sycamores.
- May not miss any rehearsal, for any reason, and may have no more than 2 tardies.

CATEGORY B – THREE-YEAR MEMBER (\$200-\$300*)

In order to qualify for this scholarship, the following conditions must be met:

- Must be in their third year of participation with the Marching Sycamores. These do not have to be consecutive years.
- Must miss no more than one rehearsal, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (*class conflict tardies are exempt*).

CATEGORY C – FOUR-YEAR MEMBER (\$300-\$500*)

- Must be in their fourth (or more) year of participation with the Marching Sycamores. These do not have to be consecutive years.
- Must miss no more than one rehearsal, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (*class conflict tardies are exempt*).

CATEGORY D – SPECIALTY STIPEND (\$200-\$400*)

- Must miss no more than one rehearsal, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (*class conflict tardies are exempt*).

(The D Category scholarships are given out for instruments that are required by the ensemble, as a recruiting and retention incentive, on an as-needed basis).

SYCAMORE BASKETBALL BAND

For ALL scholarships/stipend categories, the following member requirements are applicable:

- Must make themselves available for the minimum required number of games (usually 15-18, though they do not necessarily have to *perform* at that number).
- Must make themselves available for a post-season game (though they may not be *scheduled* by the Director to participate).
- Must be a member in good standing (no financial obligations).
- Must be enrolled in the class at the time disbursements are made.
- Must participate in ALL scheduled, required performances as assigned by the Director after a block list. An absence *without* a substitute is an automatic forfeiture of the stipend.
- Must attend all games wearing proper uniform at all times.

CATEGORY A – WOODWINDS (\$100-\$150*)

In order to qualify for this scholarship, the following conditions must be met:

- Must perform on a woodwind instrument.
- Must miss no more than two rehearsals, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (rehearsals and performances)

CATEGORY B – BRASS (\$200-\$300*)

In order to qualify for this scholarship, the following conditions must be met:

- Must perform on a brass instrument.
- Must miss no more than two rehearsals, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (rehearsals and performances).

CATEGORY C – DRUMSET (\$300-\$400*)

In order to qualify for this scholarship, the following conditions must be met:

- Must perform on a drumset.
- Must arrive early to each rehearsal/performance to set up the equipment, and stay afterwards to break down and safely stow the equipment.
- Must miss no more than two rehearsals, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (rehearsals and performances).

CATEGORY D – SPECIALTY STIPEND (\$200-\$400*)

- Must miss no more than two rehearsals, for any reason.
- Must not have more than three tardies, for any reason (rehearsals and performances).

(The D Category scholarships are given out for instruments that are required by the ensemble, as a recruiting and retention incentive, on an as-needed basis).
